After leaving the pop band **Vertical Horizon**, songwriter Chopper moved to Austin, TX and formed **Kissinger**. With Chopper behind the mic, the band has released three CDs on WCI Records, and is currently working on a fourth to be released this fall. The band has won 6 Austin Music Awards over the years, as well as grabbing the Austin Music Foundation's very competitive Incubator Award in 2005, which fully funded the recording of their upcoming release *Underwater*.

Chopper's songs have charted nationally on college radio and appeared on television, most recently on UPN's **Veronica Mars**. A song of his has also been featured on a **Tony Hawk** video game designed for Playstation mobile phones.

In 2005 Chopper received an award from the internationally known songwriter's union **ASCAP**. The award recognizes promising young songwriting talent.

For the last 12 years, Chopper has toured across the country performing as a solo artist and with bands. He has shared the stage with such big name acts as Third Eye Blind, Reverend Horton Heat, The Allman Brothers, Cake and Edwin McCain to name a few.

Described as a tall, Tex-ified Elvis Costello, Chopper combines his unique story-telling charm, and unforgettable melodies to create a captivating solo performance. After spending the last 18 months in the studio crafting his finest songs to date, Chopper, once again, is revving up to tour the United States.
